PUBLIC NOTICE FOR STAKEHOLDERS ENGAGEMENT IN UPDATING OF THE ROAD REGISTER

Kenya Roads Board (KRB) is a State Corporation established under the Kenya Roads Board Act No. 7 of 1999. The object and purpose for which the Board is established is to oversee the road network in Kenya and coordinate the maintenance, rehabilitation and development funded by the KRB Fund and to advise the Cabinet Secretary responsible for Roads & Transport on all matters related thereto.

The Board, on behalf of the Ministry of Roads and Transport and in consultation with road sector stakeholders is updating the road register to address the comments received since the gazettelement of the current road register in January 2016.

The Board in conjunction with Intergovernmental Relations Technical Committee (IGRTC) held the first stakeholders' workshop on 7th -8th July, 2022, in which the updated road register was presented and discussed. Having addressed additional stakeholder's comments and to finalize the update process, the Board has organized a second national stakeholder's engagement meeting to deliberate and validate the revised road register before gazettelement.

The members of the public are advised to access the updated road register through the KRB website (www.krb.go.ke). Any feedback should be sent on or before 3rd March, 2023.

The stakeholder's engagement meeting will be held on **February 21, 2023** at Weston Hotel, Nairobi starting 8.30am.
